- Working closely with Circa's Marketing Coordinator to lead sales and advertising of the Circa Classes programs.
- Managing a small pool of casual trainers.
- Maintain records and statistics of Circa Classes programs, participants and equipment.

Some additional information

- You must be able to legally work in Australia.

- You will be required to have current First Aid qualifications and good knowledge of Work Health Safety requirements in a circus environment.
- You will be required to travel to offsite workshops therefore a current drivers licence is required.
